



WALK THE LINE

Set up space where participants stand in a line and can move 2 steps right or left. Instructor reads each statement. Students remain in a line for 10 seconds following the statement. Instructor says “Go” and students move to **left if they agree** with the statement and **right if they disagree**. THERE IS NO MIDDLE GROUND. Instructors are encouraged to ask students to explain why they chose their position. Do not allow students to criticize others opinions. Once all viewpoints are heard, see if any students would like to switch positions. Return to home base center line for next statement.

Example Statements (Instructor can adjust/tailor list to fit the group.)

- Success has more to do with whom you know than what you know.
- If I could, I would like to know the exact date I will die.
- Our school has a positive culture.
- People should get married before having children.
- Tik Tok should be banned.
- I put the same effort into school as I do my extracurricular activities.
- You should go to college after graduating high school.
- Teachers want to help each student succeed.
- I believe in love at first sight.
- Marijuana should be legal.
